Section 1. EDINA, CITY OF; COUNCIL; TERMS OF OFFICE. At the city elections in 1976 for the city of Edina, three councilmen shall be elected. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall serve for four years. The candidate receiving the third highest number of votes shall serve for two years. Thereafter, all councilmen shall serve for terms as provided by law. Beginning with the 1976 city election the mayor shall be elected for a four year term.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon its approval by the city council of the city of Edina and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

An act relating to Ramsey county; allowing the county board to set sheriff's fees within the county; amending Laws 1974, Chapter 435, Section 3.10.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 1974, Chapter 435, Section 3.10, is amended to read:

Sec. 3.10. **RAMSEY COUNTY; SHERIFF; FEES.** (a) <u>Subdivision 1.</u> **SCHEDULE.** The fees charged and collected for the services listed by the sheriff of Ramsey county are as follows and no other or greater fees shall be charged for: <u>shall be set by the Ramsey county board and</u> <u>a schedule of those fees shall be filed with the sheriff's office.</u>

(1) Serving a summons, warrant, writ, subpoena, or any process issued by a court of record, \$2 for each person served;

(2) Milcage for all papers served, 15 cents a mile traveled;

(3) Compensation for physical levics, replevins, writs of attachment and garnishment, and like process, the hourly rate to be established by the county board, such rate to be in addition to the charges described in (A) and (B);

(4) Conduct of sales and issuances of certificates of sale, \$6;

(5) Making diligent search and inquiry and returning summons when defendants cannot be found, \$1 plus mileage charges described in (B).

(b)-Subd. 2. ADDITIONAL FEE; SUMMONS AND COMPLAINT.

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In Ramsey county, the sheriff shall charge <u>a-an additional</u> fee of <u>\$1-to</u> <u>be</u> <u>set</u> <u>by</u> <u>the</u> <u>county</u> <u>board</u> for receiving, indexing and putting in line for service each summons and complaint left with him for service. This fee is in addition to other fees now provided by law, and is to be absorbed by the plaintiff in the action. It is not to be charged to the defendant nor taxed as costs against him in the action or any proceedings ancillary thereto.

Sec. 2. APPROVAL BY BOARD. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the board of county commissioners of Ramsey county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
