307.08 **CEMETERIES; INDIAN BURIAL GROUNDS; DAMAGES; DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS; PENALTY.** <u>Subdivision 1.</u> Every person who shall wilfully destroy, mutilate, injure, or remove any tombstone, monument, or structure placed in any <u>public or private</u> cemetery <u>or authenticated and identified Indian burial ground</u>, or any fence, railing, or other work erected for protection or ornament, or any tree, shrub, or plant within the limits thereof, and every person who, without authority from the trustees or owner, shall discharge any firearms upon or over the grounds of any <u>public or private</u> cemetery <u>or authenticated</u> <u>and identified Indian burial ground</u>, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

<u>Subd.</u> 2. Every <u>authenticated and identified Indian burial ground</u> <u>shall be posted every 75 feet around its perimeter with signs listing the</u> <u>activities prohibited by subdivision 1 and the penalty for violation.</u>

<u>Subd. 3.</u> The state archaeologist and the Indian affairs board shall authenticate and identify Indian burial grounds when requested by the political subdivision which has title to Indian burial grounds.

<u>Subd. 4. The cost of authentication and identification shall be the</u> responsibility of the political subdivision requesting said identification and authentication.

<u>Subd. 5. The size, description and information on the sign must be</u> <u>approved by the Minnesota state historical society. The political subdi-</u> <u>vision which has title to the Indian burial ground must supply the</u> <u>signs and provide for their installation.</u>

Subd. 6. The Indian affairs board must approve any request to relocate an authenticated and identified Indian burial ground.

CHAPTER 49-HLF.No.1999

An act relating to game and fish; providing temporary permits for handicapped hunters; amending Minnesota Statutes, 1975 Supplement, Section 98.48, Subdivision 12.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes, 1975 Supplement, Section 98.48, Subdivision 12, is amended to read:

Subd. 12. GAME AND FISH; TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT PERMITS FOR HANDICAPPED HUNTERS. The commissioner may issue special permits, without fee, to shoot or hunt from a standing vehicle, to licensed hunters who are physically unable to walk with or

without crutches, braces or other mechanical support because of a temporary or permanent disability; provided however that any such permittees shall be subject to all laws, rules, regulations and orders for the taking of game which are not inconsistent with this subdivision. A temporary disability shall qualify an applicant for an annual permit pursuant to this subdivision. A disability once established as permanent shall qualify an applicant for a permanent to this subdivision.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect the day following final enactment.

An act relating to state lands; authorizing the conveyance of certain state lands in Goodhue county to the city of Red Wing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF STATE LANDS; RED WING, CITY OF. Subdivision 1. The governor, upon recommendation of the commissioner of administration, may transfer and convey, in the name of the state of Minnesota, to the city of Red Wing, the following described lands for recreational purposes only, owned by the state of Minnesota in connection with the department of corrections facility at Red Wing, and situated in the county of Goodhue, state of Minnesota:

The South Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 113, Range 14, Goodhue County, Minnesota; except the West 10 Acres thereof;

That part of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 113, Range 14, Goodhue County, Minnesota, lying south of a line 430.00 feet north of, measured at a right angle to and parallel with, the south line of said North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33;

The Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 34, Township 113, Range 14, Goodhue County, Minnesota;

The Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 34, Township 113, Range 14, Goodhue County, Minnesota;
