An act relating to the county of Carlton; authorization of certain payments to the city of Cloquet.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CARLTON COUNTY; PAYMENTS TO CLOQUET. The county of Carlton is authorized to pay the city of Cloquet, on an annual basis moneys to supplement the costs, witness fees and legal services for misdemeanors arising within the city of Cloquet.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect upon approval by a majority of the members of the county board of Carlton county and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

## CHAPTER 73—H.F.No.62

An act relating to towns; annual audit report; eliminating the requirement that a copy of the report be furnished to the state auditor; amending Minnesota Statutes 1976, Section 366.22.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1976, Section 366.22, is amended to read:

366.22 TOWNS; ANNUAL AUDIT REPORT. The clerk shall post a copy of the report at the place of holding the annual meeting at least half an hour before the time for opening the polls. The report shall also be publicly read by the clerk to the meeting, and the whole or any portion thereof may be referred by the meeting to a committee, which shall examine the same and report to the meeting thereon. For making the report the clerk shall receive one-half of the fees allowed by law for making the original report. One eopy of the report shall be furnished promptly to the state auditor.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day following its final enactment,
