An act relating to state lands; authorizing the exchange of certain public lake access land in Polk county.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF STATE LANDS; POLK COUNTY. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 94.341 to 94.347, or any other law to the contrary, the governor upon recommendation of the commissioner of administration shall transfer and convey, by quit claim deed in the form the attorney general approves in the name of the state of Minnesota, to the Polk county farmers union association, the following described property:

government lot 7, section 29, township 148 N range 42 W, in the county of Polk.

Said described lands shall be conveyed in exchange for lands of the Polk county farmers union association, described as follows:

Section 29, Knute township, Township 148 N, range 42 west in the county of Polk.

Sec. 2. All lands received by the state in pursuance of the exchange authorized in section I shall be accepted only after the attorney general has approved the title thereof as good and sufficient.

Sec. 3. This act is effective the day following its final enactment.
