
CHAPTER 557-H.F.No.1797

An act relating to the city of Zumbrota; authorizing the sale of certain public land.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. The city of Zumbrota is authorized to sell that certain parcel of land designated as "public square" on the plat of Zumbrota, dated September 11, 1856 and filed in the office of the Goodhue county register of deeds on September 12, 1856 in Book 1 of plats, page 4;

More specifically described as that area bounded on the north by 6th street and block 67 of said plat; on the west by East avenue and block 44 of said plat; on the south by 7th street and block 66 of said plat; on the east by block 3, Stearn's Addition to the city of Zumbrota.

Sec. 2. The resolution or ordinance of the city council for the sale of land authorized in section 1 shall not be effective until it has been approved by a majority of the votes cast on the question at a regular or a special election if a petition asking for an election on the question signed by voters equal to five percent of the number of voters at the last regular election is filed with the city within 30 days following the publication of the resolution or ordinance.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon its approval by the city council of the city of Zumbrota and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

An act relating to the city of Albert Lea; authorizing the annexation of certain land located outside the city limits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **ALBERT LEA, CITY OF; ANNEXATION OF LAND.** Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the city of Albert Lea may by duly adopted resolution of its governing body annex the following described lands in the county of Freeborn in the state of Minnesota:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Government Lot 1 in Section 12, Township
