

relationship arises solely by virtue of attending meetings or conventions of their organization; unless such veteran's organizations elect by resolution to provide coverage under this chapter for such officers or members. Neither shall the chapter apply to any person employed as a household worker in, for, or about, a private home or household who earns less than \$500 in cash in any three month period from a single private home or household provided that any household worker who has earned \$500 or more from his present employer in any three month period within the previous year shall be covered by Laws 1975, Chapter 359 regardless of whether or not he has in the present quarter earned \$500. This chapter does not apply to those persons employed by a corporation where those persons are related by blood or marriage, within the third degree of kindred according to the rules of civil law, to all of the officers of the corporation, and if the corporation files a written election with the commissioner of labor and industry to have those persons excluded from this chapter. This chapter does not apply to a nonprofit association which does not pay more than \$500 in salary or wages in a year.

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#### CHAPTER 75—H.F.No.67

*An act relating to Blue Earth county; authorizing the county of Blue Earth to contract for the completion of the improvement of county ditch No. 27; setting limits for the expenditure of money for the improvement thereof; providing for the financing thereof; amending Laws 1975, Chapter 249, Section 1, Subdivision 1, as amended; and Section 2, as amended.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1, Laws 1975, Chapter 249, Section 1, Subdivision 1, as amended by Laws 1976, Chapter 157, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **BLUE EARTH COUNTY; DITCH NO. 27; IMPROVEMENT.** Subdivision 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 106, or any other law to the contrary, the county board of Blue Earth county may by contract expend a sum not to exceed ~~\$180,000~~ \$250,000 for the completion of the improvement of that certain county ditch heretofore designated county ditch No. 27, and to issue the general obligation drainage bonds of the county pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 106 in order to provide the sums expended by authority of this section and all other costs incident thereto.

Sec. 2, Laws 1975, Chapter 249, Section 2, as amended by Laws 1976, Chapter 157, Section 2, is amended to read:

Sec. 2, Laws 1975, Chapter 249, is effective June 3, 1975, and shall expire on January 1, ~~1978~~ 1983 or whenever the construction of the improvement of county ditch No. 27 of Blue Earth county has been completed and the contracts let therefor accepted in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 106.

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**CHAPTER 76—H.F.No.1214**

*An act relating to Independent School District No. 786, Bertha-Hewitt; exempting it from certain requirements for obtaining one capital loan from the equalization aid review committee; setting a limit for that loan.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, Section 124.43, Subdivision 2, Independent School District No. 786, Bertha-Hewitt, may apply for and receive one capital loan under Minnesota Statutes, Section 124.43, without obtaining the approval of the voters of the district at the election required by Minnesota Statutes, Section 124.43, Subdivision 2 and without submitting a certificate by the clerk showing the vote at an election. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, Section 124.43, Subdivision 1, the equalization aid review committee may grant Independent School District No. 786 the loan in an amount which shall not exceed:

(1) The amount requested by the district;

(2) Plus the aggregate principal amount of general obligation bonds of the district outstanding on the date of the approval of the bond issue by the voters, not exceeding the limitation on net debt of the district in section 475.53, subdivision 4, or 30 percent of the adjusted assessed value, whichever is less;

(3) Less the maximum net debt permissible for the district on the date of approval of the bond issue by the voters, under the limitation in section 475.53, subdivision 4, or 30 percent of the adjusted assessed value, whichever is less; and

(4) Less any amount by which the amount requested exceeds the total cost of the facilities for which the loan is granted, as estimated in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 124.43, Subdivision 4, provided that the loan may be approved in an amount computed as provided in clauses (1) to (3), subject to subsequent reduction in accordance with this clause.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day following final enactment.
