

"Position number 3 and position number 5 are to be filled by election. Candidates may not file for more than one position."

Subd. 3. APPLICATIONS. If the board establishes an alley system, every application for candidacy to the board shall specify the numbered position for which the applicant is filing.

Subd. 4. BALLOTS. If the board establishes an alley system, the ballots shall read as follows:

"For school board position number 3 of Independent School District Number 281" or "For school board position number 5 of Independent School District Number 281."

The names of the candidates for each seat shall be rotated on the ballots to avoid any appearance of preference for incumbents. Incumbency shall not be indicated on the ballot.

Subd. 5. DISCONTINUANCE. The board may at any time by resolution discontinue the alley system.

Subd. 6. INCUMBENTS. If the board establishes or discontinues an alley system, incumbents shall serve the entire terms to which they were elected under the prior system. If the board establishes an alley system, incumbents shall be assigned by lot to the numbered positions.

Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY.

On its effective date, section 1 applies to Independent School District No. 281, Robbinsdale.

Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.023, Subdivision 1, Clause (a), section 1 is effective without local approval on the day after final enactment.

CHAPTER 153 — H.F.No. 57

An act relating to real estate; directing a conveyance of the state's right, title and interest in certain lands to Independent School District No. 417 of Tracy, Minnesota.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF LAND; TRACY ATHLETIC FIELD.

The commissioner of revenue shall convey, without monetary consideration, by quitclaim deed in a form approved by the attorney general to

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Township 109 North, Range 40 West described as follows: Beginning 20 feet North of the NW Corner of Block 4, W.O. Lichty's Third Addition to the City of Tracy, Minnesota; thence North along the east line of First Street East for 415.00 feet; thence N 89 degrees 13 minutes 45 seconds E parallel to Hollett Street for 525.00 feet; thence North 241.87 feet to the south line of School Addition; thence N 89 degrees 13 minutes 45 seconds E for 357.92 feet to the west line of O'Brien's Addition; thence S 0 degrees 07 minutes 33 seconds W along the west line of O'Brien's Addition for 854.71 feet to the center line of Elm Street, as platted; thence S 89 degrees 21 minutes 33 seconds W along the centerline of Elm Street for 465.01 feet to the east line of Second Street East; thence North 33.00 feet; thence S 89 degrees 21 minutes 33 seconds W for 66.00 feet to the SE corner of Block 4, W.O. Lichty's Third Addition; thence North 162.80 feet to a point 20 feet North of the NE Corner of Block 4, W.O. Lichty's Third Addition; thence S 89 degrees 21 minutes 33 seconds W parallel to the north line of Block 4, W.O. Lichty's Third Addition for 350.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 12.745 acres, more or less.
