

CHAPTER 186 — S.F.No. 1122

An act relating to veterans; changing the method of appointment and termination of the administrator of the Minnesota veterans home; amending Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 198.06.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 198.06, is amended to read:

198.06 ADMINISTRATOR; APPOINTMENT; DUTIES; TERMINATION.

The Minnesota veterans home shall be governed by the commissioner and is under the management of the administrator. The administrator shall be appointed by the commissioner and shall serve in the ~~classified civil~~ unclassified service. The administrator's term of service may be terminated by the commissioner upon service by certified mail of written notice setting forth the grounds for the termination. The termination shall be effective immediately upon receipt of the written notice. ~~The person selected must be qualified under chapter 43, and must hold a master's degree in hospital administration or a related field~~ administrator shall have a current Minnesota nursing home administrator's license. The commissioner, whenever he deems it practicable, shall appoint an administrator who is a veteran as defined under section 197.447. The commissioner shall determine policy and shall adopt and enforce rules for the government of the home and proper bylaws for the conduct of its business. The commissioner shall make rules not inconsistent with this chapter respecting the admission, maintenance, conduct and discharge of residents of the home, and the disbursements of funds under its control.

CHAPTER 187 — S.F.No. 1343

An act relating to elections; providing for automatic recounts in certain judicial elections; amending Laws 1981, Chapter 29, Article V, Section 35.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 1981, Chapter 29, Article V, Section 35, is amended as follows:

Sec. 35. [204C.35] LEGISLATIVE AND JUDICIAL RACES; AUTOMATIC RECOUNTS.
