

CHAPTER 198 — H.F.No. 619

An act relating to intoxicating liquor; correcting the wording of the ballot question for a municipal liquor store referendum; amending Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 340.353, Subdivision 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 340.353, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **POPULATION CHANGE.** Any municipality in which an authorized liquor store has been established may continue to operate such municipal liquor store notwithstanding any subsequent change in population; provided, that within one year after the effective date of the census by which such municipality exceeds 10,000 in population, the question, "Shall the city continue to operate its municipal liquor store ~~rather than issue private liquor licenses?~~" is submitted to the voters of the city at a general or special municipal election and a majority of the voters voting upon the question at the election vote in the affirmative upon the question. The notice of the election shall show that the question, "Shall the city continue to operate its municipal liquor store ~~rather than issue private liquor licenses?~~" is to be submitted to the electors at the election.

Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This act is effective the day following final enactment.

CHAPTER 199 — H.F.No. 704

An act relating to motor vehicles; providing for the taxation and registration of certain collector's vehicles; including additional vehicles entitled to classic car license plates; redefining a private passenger vehicle for certain purposes; clarifying certain requirements for front and rear bumpers; providing penalties; amending Minnesota Statutes 1980, Sections 168.10, Subdivision 1b; and 169.73.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
