

CHAPTER 412 — H.F.No. 2068

An act relating to intoxicating liquor; authorizing the city of International Falls to issue one short term on-sale liquor license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. INTERNATIONAL FALLS; SHORT TERM LIQUOR LICENSE.

Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the city of International Falls may issue, without fee, to a nonprofit organization or corporation, one on-sale license for the sale and serving of intoxicating liquor upon any school grounds or in any schoolhouse or building of Independent School District No. 361 or any building or property of the city of International Falls. The license shall be valid for a stated term of not to exceed seven consecutive days during 1983.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act is effective upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 413 — H.F.No. 1920

An act relating to economic development; excepting motor carriers from the definition of "business license;" amending Minnesota Statutes 1981 Supplement, Section 362.452, Subdivision 2a.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1981 Supplement, Section 362.452, Subdivision 2a, is amended to read:

Subd. 2a. LICENSE; EXCEPTIONS. "Business license" or "license" does not include the following:

(1) Any occupational license issued by a licensing board listed in section 214.01 or any occupational registration issued by the commissioner of health pursuant to section 214.13;

(2) Any license issued by a county, home rule charter city, statutory city, township or other political subdivision;

(3) Any license required to practice the following occupation regulated by the following sections:
