88.648 FALSE STATEMENT; GROSS MISDEMEANOR; MISDEMEANOR.

Any person who makes any false statement in any application, form, or other statement for the purpose of obtaining any written consent or transportation permit bill of sale as described in sections 88.641 to 88.644 is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.

Except as otherwise provided in this subdivision, any person who violates any provision of sections 88.641 to 88.647, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Sec. 5. REPEALER.

<u>Minnesota Statutes</u> 1982, sections 88.641, subdivision 3; 88.643; 88.646; and 88.649, are repealed.

CHAPTER 134 — S.F.No. 1067

An act relating to crimes; exempting participants in supervised research programs from arrest for certain driving violations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 169.121, by adding a subdivision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1982, section 169.121, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 10. RESEARCH PROGRAMS. No person is guilty of a violation of this section committed while participating in a research or demonstration project conducted by the Minnesota highway safety center created pursuant to section 136.147. This subdivision applies only to conduct occurring while operating a state-owned vehicle under the supervision of personnel of the center on the grounds of the center.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act is effective the day after final enactment.
