

CHAPTER 413—H.F.No. 1740

An act relating to criminal sexual conduct; clarifying the definition of "consent"; amending Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 609.341, subdivision 4.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 609.341, subdivision 4, is amended to read:

Subd. 4. "Consent" means a voluntary uncoerced manifestation of a present agreement to perform a particular sexual act with the actor.

Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

Section 1 is effective August 1, 1988, and applies to crimes committed on or after that date.

CHAPTER 414—H.F.No. 1766

An act relating to local government; making explicit the power of towns to take certain action at a special meeting; amending Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 477A.018, subdivision 1.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 477A.018, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **AUTHORIZATION.** Notwithstanding section 477A.016 or any other law, a statutory or home rule charter city may by ordinance, and a town may by the affirmative vote of the electors at its the annual town meeting or at a special town meeting, impose a tax of up to three percent on the gross receipts from the furnishing for consideration of lodging at a hotel, motel, rooming house, tourist court, or resort, other than the renting or leasing of it for a continuous period of 30 days or more. A statutory or home rule charter city may by ordinance impose the tax authorized under this subdivision on the camping site receipts of a municipal campground.
