- Subd. 3. The revenue received pursuant to this section by Independent School District 710 shall be deposited in the bond redemption fund of the district and shall be used only to retire the bonds issued on May 1, 1981, or subsequent refunding issues in the amount of \$6,000,000.

## CHAPTER 490—H.F.No. 2422

An act relating to agriculture; clarifying certain exemptions; specifying property exempt from final process issued by a court; modifying the exemption for employee benefits; amending Minnesota Statutes 1986, sections 323.24; and 550.37, subdivisions 5, 18, and 24.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1986, section 323.24, is amended to read:

# 323.24 NATURE OF A PARTNER'S RIGHT IN SPECIFIC PARTNER-SHIP PROPERTY.

A partner is coowner with the other partners of specific partnership property holding as a tenant in partnership.

The incidents of this tenancy are such that:

- (1) A partner, subject to the provisions of this chapter and to any agreement between the partners, has an equal right with the other partners to possess specific partnership property for partnership purposes; but has no right to possess such property for any other purpose without the consent of the other partners;
  - (2) A partner's right in specific partnership property is not assignable except
