CHAPTER 552-S.F.No. 1673

An act relating to intoxicating liquor; authorizing the dispensing of intoxicating liquor at the St. Cloud Civic Center; authorizing an on-sale liquor license for the T. B. Sheldon Memorial Auditorium in the city of Red Wing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR AT ST. CLOUD CIVIC CENTER.

Notwithstanding any law, charter provision or ordinance to the contrary, the city of St. Cloud may:

- (1) dispense intoxicating liquor at on-sale at the premises known and used as the St. Cloud Civic Center without a license therefor, or
- (2) authorize the holder of a retail intoxicating liquor license issued by the city of St. Cloud or an adjacent city to dispense intoxicating liquor at the premises known and used as the St. Cloud Civic Center, provided that the licensee has been engaged to dispense intoxicating liquor at an event held by the city or by a person or organization permitted to use the premises.

Intoxicating liquor may be dispensed at the St. Cloud Civic Center under this section only to members or guests of a person or organization leasing space in the premises for a convention, banquet, conference, meeting or social event, but not for any elementary, secondary or college athletic event. Authority to dispense intoxicating liquor under this section is in addition to any license authorized by law or ordinance. All provisions of law, charter or ordinance governing the sale and serving of intoxicating liquor under this section.
