Sec. 13. Minnesota Statutes 1992, section 66A.03, is amended to read:

66A.03 INCORPORATION.

Domestic mutual insurance companies are incorporated under the provisions of chapter 300. Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, the certificate or articles of incorporation shall comply with section 300.025, other than:

(1) the requirement that a majority of board members must always be residents of this state; and

(2) the requirements of section 300.025, paragraph (a), clause (7).

Minnesota Statutes 1992, sections 60A.80; 60A.801; and 60A.802, are repealed.

CHAPTER 427—H.F.No. 2487

An act relating to local government; authorizing towns in Olmsted county to adopt and enforce the state building code.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CERTAIN TOWNS; STATE BUILDING CODE.

The towns of Cascade, Dover, Elmira, Eyota, Farmington, Haverhill, High Forest, Kalmar, Marion, New Haven, Orion, Oronoco, Pleasant Grove, Quincy, Rochester, Rock Dell, Salem, and Viola may adopt and enforce the state building code under Minnesota Statutes, sections 16B.59 to 16B.73.
