No person shall operate any motor vehicle equipped with a bug deflector of nontransparent material having more than one inch of material extending above the highest part of the ~~front of the~~ hood, excluding any decorative ornament, and no person shall operate any motor vehicle equipped with a bug deflector of transparent material having more than three inches of material extending above the highest part of the ~~front of the~~ hood, excluding any decorative ornament; provided that trucks and truck-tractors of 12,000 pounds gross vehicle weight or larger may be operated with a clear, uncolored bug deflector extending no more than six inches above the highest part of the ~~front of the~~ hood, excluding any decorative ornament.

Sec. 7. Minnesota Statutes 1992, section 169.851, subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. **EXCEPTION FOR FARM AND FOREST PRODUCTS.** The maximum weight provisions of this section do not apply to the first haul of unprocessed or raw farm products and the transportation of raw and unfinished forest products when the prescribed maximum weight limitation is not exceeded by more than ten percent.

Sec. 8. Minnesota Statutes 1993 Supplement, section 221.0314, subdivision 10, is amended to read:

Subd. 10. **INSPECTION, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE.** Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, part 396, is incorporated by reference, except that sections 396.1, 396.9, and 396.17 to ~~396.25~~ 396.23 of that part are not incorporated.
