

CHAPTER 29—H.F.No. 1820

An act relating to the Cambridge State Hospital; naming a cemetery; providing for a sign; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 246.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [246.325] GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE.

The cemetery located on the grounds of the Cambridge State Hospital shall be known as the Garden of Remembrance. The commissioner of human services shall approve the wording and design for a sign at the cemetery indicating its name. The commissioner may approve a temporary sign before the permanent sign is completed and installed. All costs related to the sign must be paid with nonstate funds.

CHAPTER 30—S.F.No. 692

An act relating to natural resources; deleting land from the Mississippi Recreational River Land Use District in Wright and Sherburne Counties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. DELETION FROM MISSISSIPPI RECREATIONAL RIVER LAND USE DISTRICT IN WRIGHT AND SHERBURNE COUNTIES.

(a) The following area is deleted from the Mississippi Recreational River Land Use District in Wright County: That part of government lots 3 and 4 located in Section 26, Township 121 North, Range 23 West, lying south and west of Wright County State-Aid Highway Number 42.

(b) The following area is deleted from the Mississippi Recreational River Land Use District in Sherburne County: That part of government lots 1, 2, and 3 in Section 35, Township 33 North, Range 28 West, lying north and east of Sherburne County Road Number 14; and that part of government lot 2 of Section 36, Township 33 North, Range 28 West, lying north and east of Sherburne County Road Number 14.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act is effective the day following final enactment.

CHAPTER 31—S.F.No. 1116

An act relating to natural resources; requiring lifejackets for children aboard watercraft; amending Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 86B.501, by adding a subdivision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 86B.501, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 3. **GRANT ALLEN LAW; LIFEJACKET REQUIRED FOR CHILDREN.** (a) No person may operate a watercraft under way with a child under ten years of age aboard unless the child is:

(1) wearing an appropriate personal flotation device approved under subdivision 1; or

(2) below the top deck or in an enclosed cabin.

(b) Paragraph (a) does not apply to commercial watercraft where the child is a passenger and the operator is licensed by the state of Minnesota or the United States Coast Guard to carry passengers for hire. Paragraph (a) also does not apply if the watercraft is anchored for the purpose of swimming or diving.

(c) A first violation of this subdivision prior to May 1, 2006, shall not result in a penalty, but is punishable only by a safety warning.

(d) Any violation other than a violation addressed in paragraph (c) is to be considered a petty misdemeanor.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
