

**CHAPTER 176—S.F.No. 2749**

*An act relating to counties; removing limit in county expenditures for soldiers' rest; amending Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 375.36, subdivision 1.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2004, section 375.36, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. ~~\$3,500 yearly limit~~ **County powers; soldiers' rest.** A county board may purchase a plot of ground in any duly organized cemetery lying, in whole or part, in the county, or in a contiguous county, to be designated and used exclusively as a soldiers' rest, ~~and~~. The county may appropriate money for its cost, embellishment, and upkeep, and for the opening and the closing of graves in it, ~~not more than \$3,500 in any one year.~~

**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
