CHAPTER 236-H.F.No. 2896

An act relating to public buildings; removing a requirement that a city hold a referendum before building, equipping, or maintaining a memorial for war veterans; amending Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 416.01.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2006, section 416.01, is amended to read:

### 416.01 MEMORIALS FOR HAR VETERANS.

The governing body of any city of this state, however organized, may, after the approval of a majonity of the voters of such city, voting on the question at a special election eattect for the purpose, or at a general eleetion or an anmat eleetion, in the notice whereof the proposal to do so has been submitted for approval or rejection, adopt an ordinance providing for the erection, equipment, and maintenance of a building or monument or parks in recognition of the services performed by soldiers, sailors, marines, and war veterans of the United States. The ordinance may also provide for the supervision and control of such the building or monument or parks after its erection. The estimated cost, as determined by the governing body, of suctr the monument or parks or building, stratt must be stated in such notice and in the proposal to be voted upom, providect, that the minutes of the meeting in which the ordinance is adopted and no sum shall be expended for anty suctr purpose the monument, park, or building in an amount more than ten percent in excess of the amount so stated in such rotice the minutes. The governing body of such the city, after such approval, is authorized to may acquire a site within such the city upon which such the monument or parks or building may be erected, provided, that before such chection the site stath be designated and the cost thereof specified in suchrefeetion riotice.
