

and in accordance with the rules and regulations and laws governing such public cemetery association so accepting.

Subd. 4. After any such transfer, all lot owners of the former association shall continue their ownership and shall be entitled to the same rights and privileges with respect to their lots as are accorded to lot owners by the public cemetery association to which such transfer was made and shall thereafter be subject to all the rules, regulations and laws governing such public cemetery association.

CHAPTER 299—H. F. No. 1030

An act relating to definitions applicable to Minnesota Labor union democracy act; amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 179.26.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 179.26, is amended to read:

179.26. Definitions applicable from Section 179.26 to Section 179.29. When used in sections 179.26 to 179.29, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, each of the following words: employee, labor organization, strike, and lockout shall have the meaning ascribed to it in section 179.01.

CHAPTER 300—H. F. No. 1031

An act relating to Street Railway Franchises in a city of the third class; connection of street railways with other territory; and repealing Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 451.01.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Repealer.** Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 451.01, is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 301—H. F. No. 1032

An act relating to cancelation of uncollectible drafts or accounts due to the state: amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 10.12.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 10.12, is amended to read:

10.12. **Uncollectible drafts canceled.** *When any draft or account due to the state is found to be uncollectible by any department, it shall report such fact to the executive council, and the executive council may cancel such draft or account upon the approval of the attorney general.*

CHAPTER 302—H. F. No. 1033

An act repealing Laws 1921, Chapter 331, relating to water systems in certain villages.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Repealer.** Laws 1921, Chapter 331, is hereby repealed.

An act relating to the rate of tax levy for certain cities; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 426.03.
