CHAPTER 92-S. F. 143

An act relating to old age assistance; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 256.15, Subdivision 4, and repealing Section 256.151.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 256.15. Subdivision 4, is hereby amended to read:

256.15. Subd. 4. The prohibition against granting relief to a recipient of old age assistance, as contained in Minnesota Statutes 1945, Sec. 256.15, Subd. 3, is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Sec. 256.151, is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 93-S. F. 62

An act authorizing the Commissioner of Conservation to sell certain lands.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Sale of certain lands authorized. The commissioner of conservation is hereby authorized to sell the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fourteen (14), Township One Hundred Thirty-nine (139), Range Thirty-seven (37), Becker County, in the same manner as provided by law for the sale of other state swamp lands, notwithstanding the fact that such lands lie within the boundary of a state forest.
