CHAPTER 8-S. F. No. 126

An act relating to the Minnesota Board of Nursing; increasing the per diem allowance for board members; and increasing the annual registration fee for registered nurses; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 148.201, and Section 148.231, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 148.201, is amended to read:

148.201 Board of nursing, per diem. Each member of the board shall receive, in addition to necessary traveling and hotel expenses, \$10 \$20 per day for each day actually engaged in the discharge of her duties, including travel time and a reasonable number of days for the preparation of examination questions and grading examination papers, in addition to the time actually spent in conducting examinations and surveys.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 148.231, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

148.231 Registration. Subdivision 1. Annual registration and certificate; fee; penalty. Every person licensed to practice nursing as a registered nurse shall be registered with the board as a licensed registered nurse, and in addition to the license, shall be issued a registration certificate for a calendar year. The registration shall be annually renewed for each calender year and the board shall, on or before December 1 of each year, mail an application to such a licensee for renewal registration and such licensee shall on or before the last day of such calendar year after receipt of such application, fill in same and return it to the board with a registration fee of \$1 \$2. A penalty fee of \$1 shall be added for applications postmarked after the last day of such calendar year. Upon receipt of the application and the fee, the board shall verify the accuracy of the application and issue to such applicant a certificate of renewal registration for the next calendar year.
