other provision of law, may establish by order the seasons, limits and methods for the taking of fish therefrom and such other regulations relating thereto as he deems desirable; provided the above may be done only on waters to which the public has free access after a public hearing has been held in the county where the lake or stream, or major portion thereof, is located. Notice of said public hearing shall be published once in a legal newspaper within the county or counties where the lake is located not less than seven days prior to the hearing.

#### CHAPTER 431—S. F. No. 569

An act relating to the State Agricultural Society; increasing annual payments to the governing board and its president; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 37.05, as amended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 37.05, as amended by Laws 1963, Chapter 388, Section 1, is amended to read:

State Agricultural Society; officers; compensation; ex-37.05 The annual empensation honorarium of the president of the governing board shall be \$1,000 \$1,400, and that of the other members \$600 \$1,000 each, which compensation honorarium shall be in full for all their services commencing January 1, 1965. On the final day of the annual meeting of the society, of each year, the board shall elect a secretary, who shall hold office for one year and until his successor is elected and qualified. The compensation of the secretary shall be fixed by the board. The board may also appoint a treasurer for the term of one year and fix his compensation. The secretary and the treasurer shall each execute to the society for the use and benefit of the society, the state of Minnesota, and all persons injured by failure to observe its conditions, a penal bond in such sum as may be fixed by the governing board of the society and with such sureties as the president and secretary of the society may approve, conditioned that he will pay over to the society, the state of Minnesota, and all persons on demand all moneys to which they may be entitled which may have come into his hands in virtue or by reason of his office as such secretary or treasurer. The treasurer shall keep all accounts and fiscal records of the society. The board may

designate the secretary as the treasurer of the society. In addition, the board may allow the traveling expenses of its members and of the secretary and treasurer or other employees while in the performance of their official duties, the claims for which shall in all cases be itemized in full and verified before allowance.

## CHAPTER 432—S. F. No. 672

An act relating to public employees benefits upon retirement; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Chapter 353, by adding a new section thereto.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Chapter 353, is amended by adding a new section thereto to read:

[353.75] Public Employees retirement; certain retirement annuity benefits. Any public employee who retired on or after December 31, 1964, and who (1) has attained the age of 65 years, and who (2) had more than 22 years of continuous service in his first public employment, (3) had more than five years of subsequent continuous service in public employment before his retirement, (4) and has made contributions to the public employees retirement fund during all his public employment, and who (5) has not withdrawn any of his contributions to the public employees retirement fund, is entitled to receive a retirement annuity from the effective date of this act based upon the sum total of such periods of public employment in like manner as if his public employment had been continuous.
