

CHAPTER 25—H. F. No. 81

An act relating to forestry; authorizing the commissioner of conservation to issue permits for the salvaging or cutting of certain trees for fuelwood for personal use; prescribing a fee therefor; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Chapter 90, by adding a section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Chapter 90, is amended by adding a section to read:

[90.195] Timber lands; special use permit. *The commissioner, for a \$5 fee, may issue a permit to salvage or cut not to exceed 25 cords of fuelwood per year for personal use from either or both of the following sources: (1) Dead, down, and diseased trees; (2) other trees that are of negative value under good forest management practices. Such permits may be issued for a period not to exceed one year.*

Sec. 2. **Effective date.** *This act is effective July 1, 1967.*

CHAPTER 26—H. F. No. 83

An act repealing certain laws relating to timber identification; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1965, Sections 90.60, 90.61, 90.62, and 90.63.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Timber lands; identification of timber; repealer.**

Minnesota Statutes 1965, Sections 90.60, 90.61, 90.62, and 90.63 are repealed.

Sec. 2. This act is effective July 1, 1967.
