CHAPTER 320-S. F. No. 1851

An act relating to county state-aid highways; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 162.02, Subdivision 7.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 162.02, Subdivision 7, is amended to read:

Subd. 7. County state-aid highways; relocation; establishment of system in new location or over established roads. The county board of any county may establish and locate any county state-aid highway on new location where there is no existing road, or it may establish and locate the highway upon or over any established road or street or a specified portion thereof within its limits; provided, that no county state-aid highway shall be established or located within the corporate limits of any city, village, or borough without the approval of the governing body of the city, village, or borough, except that when a county state-aid highway is relocated the approval of the plans by the governing body shall be deemed to be a transfer of the previous location of the highway to the jurisdiction of the city, village, or borough. The approval shall be in the manner and form required by the commissioner.

CHAPTER 321-S. F. No. 174

An act relating to the Owatonna state school; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 247.14,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 247.14, is amended to read:

247.14 Owatonna state school; vocational training for mentally deficient. The Owatonna state school shall be used as a state institution to provide academic education, educational, vocational and social training, and such related therapeutic and rehabilitative services as are necessary to achieve the same for mentally deficient persons under age 21.
