An act relating to bakeries and bakery products; providing statewide bakery sanitation and bakery product standards of identity and labeling; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Chapter 31, by adding a section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Chapter 31, is amended by adding a section to read:

[31.77] Bakery sanitation and standards. No city, village, borough, or other lawful authority may require sanitary requirements for bakeries, appurtenances, distribution vehicles, and bakery products, or standards of identity or labeling requirements for bakery products, which are not consistent with laws of this state administered by the state department of agriculture or rules or regulations promulgated by the commissioner of agriculture. Within 90 days after the effective date of this act the commissioner shall promulgate rules and regulations relating to sanitary requirements for bakeries, appurtenances, distribution vehicles, bakery products, standards of identity and labeling requirements for bakery products which are at least equal to and no lower than those fixed by the food and drug administration of the United States department of health, education, and welfare.
