For the purposes of this section, an "alcoholic beverage" means any liquid containing more than one half of one percent of alcohol by volume.

An act expanding the jurisdiction of the probate court in certain counties; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 525.011, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 525.011, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

525.011 PROBATE COURT; CIVIL AND CRIMINAL JURIS-DICTION. Subdivision 1. Except in counties having a city of the first class or in counties having a population of more than 30,000 according to the 1950 federal census, the probate court shall also exercise the powers, duties and jurisdiction conferred upon municipal courts by Minnesota Statutes,—Chapter Chapters 488, 491, 492, and 493, or under any other law enacted in lieu thereof which provides for uniform powers, duties and jurisdiction of municipal courts.
