An act authorizing Blue Earth county to establish, operate and maintain refuse disposal facilities; amending Laws 1969, Chapter 132, Sections 1 and 3.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1969, Chapter 132, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. BLUE EARTH COUNTY; REFUSE DISPOSAL. This act shall apply to Blue Earth county and the terms "board of commissioners" and "county board" as used in this act shall mean the county board of Blue Earth county. The board of commissioners may acquire by purchase, lease, or gift or by condemnation as provided by law, any land or interest in land within the county which the county board deems suitable for use as refuse disposal facility sites.
