beyond the city limits of Minneapolis, and three appointees from among the membership of the Minneapolis public library board while serving as such library board members, the membership to represent the citizens of Hennepin county exclusive of Minneapolis both geographically and politically, all of whom shall be residents of the county of Hennepin exclusive of Minneapolis at the time of their appointment. The library board shall be advisory to the county board of commissioners and shall be responsible for policy and legislative recommendations relating to the library system and shall perform such other duties and responsibilities pertinent to library matters as may be delegated by the county board of commissioners. Subject to the approval of the county board of commissioners, the library board shall appoint a library director pursuant to the provisions of Laws 1965, Chapter 855, who shall be the chief administrative officer of the library system.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon its approval by the governing body of the county of Hennepin and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
