enjoin the sale or offer for sale of any product packaged, labelled or advertised in violation of this act.

## CHAPTER 72—S.F.No.2446

An act relating to the powers of the county board of commissioners; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 375.19.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 375.19, is amended to read:

375.19 COUNTIES; SOIL CONSERVATION; ADDITIONAL POW-ERS. In addition to all other powers now or hereafter by law conferred upon county boards, authority hereby is given to receive and accept for their counties real or personal property by gift, bequest, devise, conveyance; or otherwise from any person whose care, support, treatment, or maintenance, in whole or in part, is or may be chargeable to or furnished or provided by such counties, and to hold or dispose of the same for the benefit of their counties, as by law provided in the case of other county property; to permit use of county equipment for soil conservation projects and to make annual expenditures from the general revenue fund for soil conservation purposes not exceeding an aggregate amount of one cent per acre of all lands included within soil and water conservation districts in the county. All expenditures made by any county board of commissioners subsequent to May 1, 1947, not exceeding the any annual amount herein provided for, are hereby validated.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day after final enactment.
