

keep in effect insurance or other security as required by this section, the permit carrier, being the transferor in the transaction, shall have his permit fully reinstated by the department, together with all operating authority granted theretofore, upon his filing with the department, within 15 days after the effective date of this act, public liability and indemnity insurance or bond in the amount and form as the department prescribes.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day following its final enactment.

CHAPTER 318—S.F.No.782

An act relating to courts; providing compensation and mileage allowance for jurors; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 357.26, Subdivision 1; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 593.18.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 357.26, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

357.26 COURTS; COMPENSATION AND MILEAGE OF JURORS.
 Subdivision 1. Each grand juror, petit juror and talesman shall receive ~~\$10-\$15~~ for each day in actual attendance in the district court, except in counties containing a city of the first class where such persons shall receive ~~\$6 for each day in actual attendance,~~ an amount established by the board of county commissioners and mileage for each such day in actual attendance at ~~the~~ a rate of ~~nine-not less than 13 cents and not to exceed the maximum rate provided in section 43.328~~ for each mile of the distance from his residence to the place of trial or hearing and from the place of trial or hearing to his residence, the distance to be computed by the usually traveled route, or 50 cents, whichever amount is greater.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 593.18, is repealed.

Sec. 3. This act is effective January 1, 1976.
