

CHAPTER 427—H.F.No.1536

An act relating to crimes; permitting certain ticket sale service fees; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 609.805, by adding a subdivision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 609.805, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 3. CRIMES AND CRIMINALS; TICKET SCALPING; SERVICE FEES; EXCEPTION. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 shall not prohibit charging a fee for services rendered in connection with the sale of a ticket to an event if the fee is permitted pursuant to a contract between the ticket seller and the promoter of an event.

Sec. 2. This act shall be effective upon final enactment.

CHAPTER 428—H.F.No.1551

An act relating to the city of Minneapolis; policemen's pension fund uses; amending Laws 1949, Chapter 406, Section 7, as amended.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 1949, Chapter 406, Section 7, as added by Laws 1953, Chapter 127, Section 4, and amended by Laws 1965, Chapter 534, Section 1, and Laws 1973, Chapter 272, Section 1, is amended to read:

Sec. 7. **MINNEAPOLIS, CITY OF; POLICEMEN'S PENSIONS.** The policemen's pension fund shall be used only for the payment of:

(a) Service, disability or dependency pensions;

(b) Salaries of the secretary of the association in an amount not to exceed 30 percent of the base salary of a top-grade patrolman and of the president of the association in an amount not to exceed ten percent of the base salary of a top-grade patrolman;

(c) Expenses of officers and employees of the association in con-
