
CHAPTER 2—S.F.No.231

An act relating to bonds; requiring claimant filing notice of action on a bond to pay postage costs; amending Minnesota Statutes 1978, Section 574.32.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1978, Section 574.32, is amended to read:

574.32 **NOTICE.** The commissioner of insurance or the county auditor in whose office the written notice is filed shall, upon receipt of such written notice, mail one copy of the same, by certified mail, to the principal contractor, at his last known address, and to each of the sureties on his bond, at their last known addresses, and the claimant shall, at the time he files the written notice, furnish the commissioner of insurance or the county auditor in whose office the notice is filed, at least two copies of the notice. The commissioner of insurance or county auditor with whom the notice is filed shall be entitled to charge a fee of \$5 for filing the notice and may also charge a fee to cover the cost of mailing the copies as herein provided. The failure of the commissioner of insurance or the county auditor with whom the notice is filed to mail these copies as herein provided, shall in no way affect the validity of the claim or the right of the claimant to maintain an action thereon.

CHAPTER 3—S.F.No.88

An act relating to cities; allowing installment purchases by certain cities; amending Minnesota Statutes 1978, Section 465.71.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1978, Section 465.71, is amended to read:

465.71 **INSTALLMENT SALES OF PROPERTY; HOME RULE CHARTER CITIES.** A second, third or fourth class home rule charter city may purchase real or personal property under an installment contract by which title is retained by the seller or vendor as security for the purchase price, but such purchases are subject to statutory and charter provisions applicable to the purchase of real or personal property.

Sec. 2. This act is effective on the day following final enactment.
