BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: Section 1. TOFTE LIQUOR LICENSE.

Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the county board of Cook County may issue one off-sale liquor license to an establishment located in the town of Tofte, with the approval of the commissioner of public safety. The license fee shall be fixed by the board in an amount not to exceed \$500 per year. A license issued pursuant to this section shall be governed by the appropriate provisions of Minnesota Statutes. Chapter 340 to the extent consistent herewith.

CHAPTER 115 - H.F.No. 937

Section 1. DULUTH LIQUOR LICENSES.

Notwithstanding the limitations on the number of on-sale and off-sale intoxicating liquor licenses that may be issued by municipalities contained in Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.11, the city of Duluth is authorized to continue to issue the number of on-sale and off-sale intoxicating liquor licenses that it was authorized to issue during the year 1980.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This act is effective upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021, Subdivision 3.

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1980, Section 645.15, is amended to read:

645.15 COMPUTATION OF TIME.

Where the performance or doing of any act, duty, matter, payment, or thing is ordered or directed, and the period of time or duration for the performance or doing thereof is prescribed and fixed by law, such the time, except as otherwise provided in sections 645.13 and 645.14, shall be computed so as to exclude the first and include the last day of any such the prescribed or fixed period or duration of time. When the last day of such the period falls on <u>Saturday</u>, Sunday or on any day made a legal holiday, by the laws of this state or of the United States, such that day shall be omitted from the computation.

Sec. 2. [645.151] TIMELY DELIVERY OR MAILING.

When an application, payment, return, claim, statement or other document is to be delivered to or filed with a department, agency or instrumentality of this state or of a political subdivision on or before a prescribed date and the prescribed date falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, it is timely delivered or filed if it is delivered or filed on the next succeeding day which is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday.
