An act relating to the operation of snowmobiles in certain contests upon highways, public lands or waters; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 84.87, by adding a subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 84.87, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 1a. Snowmobiles; international contests; use of highways. Nothing in this section or chapter 169 shall prohibit the use of snowmobiles within the right of way of any state trunk or county state-aid highway or upon public lands or waters under the jurisdiction of the commissioner of conservation, in any international contest, subject to the consent of the official or board having jurisdiction over the highway or public lands or waters.

In permitting such contest, the official or board having jurisdiction may prescribe such restrictions or conditions as they may deem advisable.
