## CHAPTER 1—H.F.No.3

An act relating to unemployment compensation; granting authority to pay extended benefits; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 268.071, Subdivision 7.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 268.071, Subdivision 7, is amended to read:

Subd. 7. UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION; EXTENDED BENEFITS; EFFECT OF FEDERAL LAW. If the Federal-State Extended Unemployment Compensation Act of 1970 is amended so as to authorize this state to pay benefits for an extended benefit period in a manner other than that currently provided by this section, then, and in such case, all the terms and conditions contained in the amended provisions of such federal law shall become a part of this section to the extent necessary to authorize the payment of benefits to eligible individuals as permitted under such amended provision, provided that the federal share continues to be at least 50 percent of the extended benefits paid to individuals under the extended benefit program. The commissioner shall also pay benefits at the earliest possible date in the manner allowed by the Federal-State Unemployment Compensation Act of 1970, as amended through January 1, 1975, the provisions of which shall become a part of this section to the extent necessary to authorize the payment of benefits to eligible individuals.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day following final passage.
