Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. St. Louis county; courthouse. Laws 1963, Chapter 131, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 394.01 to 394.05, in St. Louis county, a the courthouse building commission eonsisting of the board of eounty commissioners, and all of the elective county officials shall have the authority to assign and reassign space and rooms to the various offices in the courthouses and county office buildings in said county.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority vote of the members of the county board of St. Louis county, and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
