## CHAPTER 149-H. F. No. 346

An act relating to motor vehicle licensing; changing the length of the periods of issuance for certain number plates; amending Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 168.12, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1961, Section 168.12, Subdivision 1 , is amended to read:
168.12 Motor vehicles; license plates. Subdivision 1. Number plates; visibility, periods of issuance. (a) The registrar, upon such approval and payment, issues to the applicant the number plates required by law, bearing an abbreviation of the state name and the number assigned. The number assigned may be a combination of a letter or sign with figures. The color of the plates and the color of the abbreviation of the state name and the number assigned shall be in marked contrast. The plates shall be lettered, spaced, or distinguished to suitably indicate the classification of the vehicle according to the regulations of the registrar. These number plates shall be so treated as to be at least 100 times brighter than the conventional painted number plates. When properly mounted on an unlighted vehicle, these number plates, when viewed from a vehicle equipped with standard headlights, shall be visible for a distance of not less than 1,500 feet and readable for a distance of not less than 110 feet. At the end of the registration periods in effect immediately before the effective date of this act, and for subsequent registration periods, the registrar shall furnish issue these number plates for atw period eommeneing fantary 1,1956 , subsequently on Jantary 4 for sueh peried as he determines: the following periods:
(1) Number plates issued under Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 168.012, Subdivision 9, 168.053, 168.27, and 168.62, Subdivision 2, shall be issued for a one year period;
(2) Number plates issued for passenger automobiles shall be issued for a three year period; and
(3) Number plates issued for any vehicle other than those specified in (1) and (2) above shall be issued for a two year period.

In any year during which these number plates are not furnished issued the registrar shall furnish issue for each annual registration a reflectorized year plate, tab, or sticker to designate the year of registration. This plate, tab, or sticker shall show the calendar year for which issued, and is valid only for that year. Unless the motor vehicle for which a number plate, number, tab, or sticker is issued,

is permanently lost, is destroyed, or is removed from the state, no number plate, number, tab, or sticker may be transferred to another motor vehicle during the calendar year in which issued.

The provisions of elause $\left\{\begin{array}{l}\text { f } \\ \text { for the entendar years 1962, 1963, }\end{array}\right.$ 1964, and 1965 shall enly apply to lieense plates issued for trueks; tracters, truek traetors, trailers and semitrailers, buses and intereity buses: For the eadendar year 1966 the provisions of elause (b) shall apply to sureh vehieles int addition to other vehieles:
(b) The registrar, upen sweh apprevat and payment, issues to the applieant the fumber plates required by law, bearing an abbreviation of the state name and the number ussignet. The number assigned may be a eembination of a letter or sign with figures: The eolor of the plates and the eelor of the abreviation of the state name and the number assigned shall be in marked eontrust. The plates shall be lettered, spaeed, or distinguished to suitably indieate the elassifieation of the wehiele aeeording to the regutations of the registrar. These number plates shall be se treated as to be at least 100 times brighter than the eonventional painted number plates: When properly mounted on at unlighted vehiele, these number plates, when tiewed frem a wehiele equipped with standard headlights; shall be visible fer a distanee of not less that 1,500 feet and readable for at distanee of tess than 410 feet. The registrar shatl furnish these number plates for a three year period commenting Jantary 4 ; 1962. During the sureeeding twe yeafs which these number plates are net furnished, the registrar shatl furnish for eaeh annual registrution a reflecterized year plate, tab; or stieker to designate the year of registration: This plate, tab, or stieker stall shew the ealendar year fer whieh issued, and is valid enly for that year, and shall be affixed by applieant to the number plate. Unless the motor whiele fer which a number plate, number, tab, or stiekef is issued, is permanently lest, is destroyed; or is removed from the state, no number plate; number, tab, or stieker may be transferred to another motor vehiele during the ealendaf year in whieh issted.

The provisions of elause fo for the ealendar years 1962, 1963, 1964, and 1965 shall apply to lieense plates issued for all motor vehrieles exeept those eovered by elause (a). For the eatendar yeur 1966 and thereafter this elatuse shall apply to all motor vehieles.
