CHAPTER 160-H. F. No. 630.

An Act to amend Section 2155, Revised Laws, 1905, relating to the membership of the live stock sanitary board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Minnesota Live Stock Breeders' Association to select and recommend one member.—That Section 2155. Revised Laws, 1905, he and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sanitary board.—The state live stock sanitary board. 2155. hereinafter called the board, or the state board, shall consist of five members, appointed by the governor, each for the term of five years and until his successor qualifies. One shall be a person selected and recommended by the Minnesota Live Stock Breeders' Association. Two shall be persons financially interested in the breeding of live stock in the state; and the other two practicing veterinarians and graduates of a regularly organized and recognized veterinary college. Appointments to fill unexpired terms shall be made from the classes to which the retiring members belonged. The board shall elect a president and a vice-president from among their number; also a veterinarian and graduate of a regularly organized and recognized veterinary college, not a member, to be its secretary and executive officer for a term of one year and until his successor qualifies. It may also employ, and dismiss at pleasure, an attorney and such other assistants as may be necessary in the performance The compensation of the secretary and of the several employees shall be fixed and their duties prescribed, by the board. No member of the board shall receive any compensation for services as such, or as an employee thereof, but the expenses of each, necessarily incurred in the discharge of his duties. shall be paid by the state.

CHAPTER 161-H. F. No. 625.

An Act to make uniform the law of warehouse receipts. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

PART I.

THE ISSUE OF WAREHOUSE RECEIPTS.

Section 1. Persons who may issue receipts.-Warehouse recoipts may be issued by any warehouseman.

Sec. 2. Form of receipts-Essential terms.-Warehouse receipts need not be in any particular form, but every such receipt must embody within its written or printed terms:
