## CHAPTER 179—H. F. No. 462 [Coded as Section 85.174] [Section 2 Not Coded]

An act authorizing the commissioner of conservation to acquire lands for state park and wayside purposes and appropriating money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[85.174] Section 1. Caribou Falls State Park. The commissioner of conservation is authorized to acquire by purchase or condemnation the following described lands in the County of Lake, State of Minnesota:

That part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and that part of Government Lot 2 lying northerly and westerly of State Trunk Highway No. 61, all in Section 36, Township 58 north of Range 6 west of the Fourth Principal Meridian, for not exceeding the sum of \$1,500.

These lands, when acquired, together with the  $NW^{1/4}$  of the NE<sup>1/4</sup> of said section, township, and range, shall be a state park known as the Caribou Falls State Park, under the supervision and control of the commissioner of conservation as provided for in other state parks.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated to the Commissioner of Conservation out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$1,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purposes of this act.

## CHAPTER 180-H. F. No. 464 [Coded as Section 85.175. Section 2 Not Coded]

An act authorizing the commissioner of conservation to acquire lands for state park and wayside purposes and appropriating money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[85.175] Section 1. Kodonce River State Park. The commissioner of conservation is authorized to acquire the
