trict, the board shall notify the board of county commissioners, which shall cause notice of hearing thereon to be given and otherwise proceed as provided in Extra Session Laws of 1959, Chapter 71, Article III, Section 3, for organization of common or independent school districts.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective only after it has been approved by a favorable vote of a majority of the members of the board of education for unorganized territory in Koochiching county and upon compliance with the provisions of Laws 1959, Chapter 368.

CHAPTER 194—H. F. No. 80

An act relating to sheriffs; authorizing counties to furnish motor vehicles thereto; amending Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 387.29.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1957, Section 387.29, is amended to read as follows:

387.29 Motor vehicles. Subdivision 1. Reimbursement for use of private vehicle. As reimbursement for use of his own private automobile by a sheriff or deputy, in the performance of his official duties, he may be paid by the county a sum not to exceed ten cents per mile for every mile so traveled.

Subd. 2. Motor vehicles furnished. In lieu of the payment set forth in subdivision 1, the board of county commissioners, by resolution, may furnish to the sheriff of the county such necessary motor vehicles and supplies therefor as are needed to carry out the duties of his office.

Subd. 3. Changes of policy. A county reimbursing a sheriff pursuant to subdivision 1 shall not exercise the power conferred by subdivision 2 without concurrence of the sheriff prior to January 1, 1963. The furnishing of motor vehicles by any county to the sheriff previous to the effective date of this act is hereby approved and validated.
