
CHAPTER 366—H.F.No.2796

An act relating to special school district No. 1 of the city of Minneapolis; compensation of directors of the board of education; amending Laws 1959, Chapter 462, Section 3, Subdivision 1, as amended.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1, MINNEAPOLIS; COMPENSATION OF DIRECTORS. Laws 1959, Chapter 462, Section 3, Subdivision 1, as amended by Laws 1963, Chapter 645, Section 3, Subdivision 1, and as renumbered subdivision 1a by Laws 1967, Chapter 661, Section 3, is amended to read:

Subd. 1a. The board of education of such district shall consist of seven directors, each of whom shall be elected at large for a term of six years, or until his successor has been elected and qualified. The directors shall receive ~~no-such~~ compensation as may be fixed by the board of education .

CHAPTER 367—H.F.No.2799

An act relating to charitable organizations; exempting firemen from the prohibition against uniformed personnel of governmental agencies or departments soliciting contributions on the behalf of a charitable organization; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 309.55, Subdivision 4, as added.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 309.55, Subdivision 4, as added by Laws 1973, Chapter 762, Section 10, is amended to read:

Subd. 4. CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS; SOLICITATIONS; UNIFORMED PERSONNEL. No charitable organization and no person acting on behalf of a charitable organization shall use any uniformed personnel of any local, state or federal agency or department to solicit contributions. This subdivision shall not apply to firemen who solicit contributions in uniform.
