## CHAPTER 372-H. F. No. 2351

An act authorizing certain counties to appropriate funds for hospitals and nursing homes; amending Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 376.08.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1965, Section 376.08, is amend-to read:

376.08 Counties; appropriations for hospitals and nursing homes. The board of county commissioners in any county in this state having 30,000 50,000 inhabitants, or less, is hereby authorized to appropriate from the general revenue fund of such county a sum not exceeding \$65,000 in any one year to aid in the acquisition of lands for hospital purposes, the erection, construction, improvement, alterations, equipment and maintenance of hospitals within such county and may appropriate from the general revenue fund of such county a sum not exceeding \$25,000 for the acquisition of land and construction of municipally owned nursing homes within such county.

## CHAPTER 373—H. F. No. 6

An act authorizing the conveyance of certain state owned land in Olmsted county to special school district number 4 of Rochester. ter.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Conveyance of state lands; Rochester school district. The governor, upon the recommendation of the commissioners of welfare and administration, shall transfer and convey by a deed without consideration in such form as the attorney general may approve in the name of the state of Minnesota to the special school district number 4 of Rochester for the site for an area vocational technical school, the following described land lying and being in Olmsted county, to wit:
