The commissioner shall submit the results of this study and a comprehensive proposal for a new registration system to the legislature at the beginning of the 1977 session.

Sec. 9. Section 4 of this act is effective May 1, 1976. Sections 7 and 8 of this act are effective the day following final enactment. The remaining sections of this act are effective November 15, 1976.

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 126.20, Subdivision 6, is amended to read:

Subd. 6. **EDUCATION; SCHOOLS AND UNIVERSITIES; EYE PROTECTION.** "Industrial quality eye protective devices," as used in this section, shall mean devices meeting the standards of the ~~American Standard Safety Code for Head, Eye, and Respiratory Protection~~ American National Standard Institute, currently identified as ~~ASA Z21-1969 Z87.1-1968~~.
