number of clerks in his office and that the salary amounts which may be saved, together with whatever has been saved, during such year through necessary vacancies, among other deputies, clerks and assistants of said register of deeds office, may, to any extent needful in any case, be used in the same year by hiring extra help at not to exceed the same rate for any of the regular work of his office when the same is greater or more hurried than is common throughout the year. Provided, however, that no such sums or any part thereof as herein provided, shall at any time be used to increase the salaries of any of the employees provided for in this act."

## CHAPTER 520-H. F. No. 1367

An act to create a Father Hennepin State Memorial Wayside in the vicinity of the Village of Isle, Mille Lacs County, Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. "Father Hennepin State Memorial Wayside" park created.—There is hereby created Father Hennepin State Memorial Wayside. Said park shall consist of the following described lands lying in Township 42 North, Range 25 West, County of Mille Lacs, State of Minnesota, when and as acquired in accordance with the terms of this act, more fully described as follows:

Government Lots 2, 3, 4 and 5, Section 3, Town-

ship 42 North, Range 25 West, all of the above described lands comprising 129.75 acres.

- Sec. 2. Tax forfeited lands to be dedicated to park.—All lands within the area described in Section 1 which have forfeited to the state for non-payment of taxes, are hereby declared vested in the State of Minnesota, free of any trust or interest in favor of the taxing units thereof and are hereby dedicated to the purposes of said State Memorial Park.
- Sec. 3. To be under division of state parks.—Said State Memorial Wayside shall be under the control and management of the division of state parks, department of conservation.

- Sec. 4. Director may accept funds and services.—The director of the division of state parks is hereby authorized to accept in the name of the state of Minnesota any funds or services donated for the purpose of improvement of said lands for park purposes.
- Sec. 5. State funds not to be used for maintenance.—No funds of the state of Minnesota shall be expended upon the maintenance of said park for a period of five years.

## CHAPTER 521-H. F. No. 1439

An act to appropriate money for the conservation and development of the state's natural resources; for maintenance and improvement of State Soldiers' Home; for the maintenance of Minnesota Department G. A. R.; for maintenance Minnesota Historical Society; for maintenance, improvement and repairs, Minnesota State Agricultural Society; for county and district agricultural societies; for aid to agricultural agents; for various stock breeders', dairymen's, horticultural and poultry associations and societies; for sheriff's per diem and mileage in certain cases; for drainage and highway assessments upon state lands; for vessel tonnage tax; for fees public land collections; for maintenance Sibley House; for maintenance of various semi-state activities; providing for appropriations to be made out of the game and fish department funds for wolf bounties and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for conservation of state's natural resources.—The sums hereinafter named, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of the general revenue fund in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purposes specified in the following sections of this act, to be available, when not otherwise stated, for each of the fiscal years ending June 30, 1942, and June 30, 1943.
