An act relating to the authorization of certain villages to appropriate funds from municipal liquor store earnings to aid in acquisition, construction, improvement, maintenance and operation of a community hospital; amending Laws 1947, Chapter 321, Section 1, and repealing Laws 1947, Chapter 321, Section 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[447.045] Section 1. Nonprofit hospital supported by municipal liquor store profits. Laws 1947, Chapter 321, Section 1, is amended to read:

Subd. 6. If the voters of any village operating an onsale, or an off-sale, or an on-sale and off-sale municipal liquor store at a general or special election vote in favor of contributing from the village liquor dispensary fund toward the acquisition, construction, improvement, maintenance, and operation of a community hospital, the council may appropriate such sums of money as said council may from time to time determine out of the net profits or proceeds of the municipal liquor store to any incorporated non-profit hospital association in the village, governed by a board of directors elected by donors of \$50 or more, who shall each have one vote; and the hospital shall be open to all residents of the community on equal terms.

Sec. 2. Laws 1947, Chapter 321, Section 2, is hereby repealed.
