phone, telegraph and electric power lines either by underground cable or conduit or otherwise, sewer and water lines, highways, railroads, and pipe lines for gas, liquids, or solids in suspension. Such certificate or conveyance may be recorded, after the time for redemption shall have expired, as other deeds of real estate, and with like effect. No assignment of the right of the state shall be given pursuant to this section after January 1, 1972.

- Subd. 2. **DRIVERS' LICENSES; FEES.** The fee for an instruction permit shall be \$1. The fee for a nonqualification certificate shall be \$2. The fee for a driver's license shall be \$3. The fee for a duplicate license shall be 50 cents. The fee for a license or certificate bearing a colored photograph thereon shall be increased by \$1.
- Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 171.07, is amended to read:

171.07 DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE LICENSE AND NONQUA-LIFICATION CERTIFICATES. Subdivision 1. The department shall, upon the payment of the required fee, issue to every applicant qualifying therefor a license as applied for, which license shall bear thereon a distinguishing number assigned to the licensee, the full name, date of birth, residence address, a description of the licensee in such manner as the commissioner deems necessary, and a space upon which the licensee shall write his usual signature with pen and ink. No license shall be valid until it has been so signed by the licensee. Except in the case of an instruction permit, every license shall bear thereon a colored photograph of the licensee. Every license issued to an applicant under the age of 21 shall be of a distinguishing color and plainly marked "provisional."

Each license certificate issued on or before July 1, 1964, shall be on an all plastic or laminated plastic card with the identifying information embossed thereon.

Subd. 2. Upon payment of the required fee for a driver's license bearing a colored photograph, the department may issue to every applicant, the age of sixteen years or over, who does not physically qualify for a driver's license, or any person not currently licensed to drive, who does not intend to apply for a driver's license under this section or who wishes to discontinue driving and surrenders his current driver's license, a nonqualification certificate. The certificate shall bear thereon a distinguishing number assigned to the applicant, the full name, date of birth, residence address, a description of the applicant in such manner as the commissioner deems necessary, and a space upon which the applicant shall write his usual signature with pen and ink.

Each nonqualification certificate shall be on an all plastic or laminated plastic card of a distinguishing color and plainly marked "non-driver."

Subd. 3. The expiration date of each nonqualification certificate of applicants under the age of 65 shall be the birthday of the applicant in the fourth year following the date of issuance of the nonqualification certificate. Nonqualification certificates issued to applicants age 65 or over shall be valid for the lifetime of the applicant.

Sec. 3. This act shall apply to every application for a nonqualification certificate, submitted on or after January 1, 1972.
