

Nothing herein contained shall be construed to repeal any law wherein any towns are classified for the purpose of fixing the salaries, or maximum salaries, of any of their officers.

This subdivision shall not apply to any county containing a city of the first class.

CHAPTER 818—H.F.No.2449

An act relating to the public retirement commission; eliminating certain annual appropriations; deleting the provisions terminating the existence of such commission; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 3.85, Subdivisions 9 and 10.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 3.85, Subdivision 9, is amended to read:

Subd. 9. **PUBLIC RETIREMENT COMMISSION; CONTINUATION; EXPENSES AND REPORTS.** ~~The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby annually appropriated from the general fund for the purposes of this section for the payment of any such expenses. Of the foregoing appropriation the sum of \$4,000 shall be available for expenditure in the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967. Any balance remaining on June 30, 1968, shall not cancel but be carried forward to the following year.~~ Expenses of the commission shall be approved by the chairman or such other member as the rules of the commission may provide and the expenses shall then be paid in the same manner as other state expenses are paid. A general summary or statement of expenses incurred by the commission and paid shall be made to the legislature at each regular session.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 3.85, Subdivision 10, is amended to read:

Subd. 10. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective May 1, 1967, ~~and shall terminate June 30, 1973.~~
