To the Rev. Mr. Parsons, for same services, nine days, twenty- Rev. Mr. Parsons. seven dollars.

To the Rev. Mr. Neill, for services as chaplain, six days, eighteen dollars.

To the Rev. Mr. Hobart, for services as chaplain, one day, three Rev. Mr. Hobart. dollars.

To the Rev. Mr. Pond, for services as chaplain, two days, six Rev. Mr. Pond. dollars.

CHAP. XXVII.—An Act to dissolve the Marriage Contract between Catharine Hathaway and her husband.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, That the marriage contract heretofore existing between Catharine Hathaway and her husband, Isaac Hathaway, be, and the same is hereby dissolved; and the said parties are hereby restored to all the rights and privileges of unmarried persons.

APPROVED, the first day of November, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.

CHAP. XXVIII.---An Act granting a Divorce to Louis Larammie from Wa-kanye-ke-win, his wife.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesola, 'That Louis Laramic is hereby divorced from his wife, Wa-kan-ye-ke-win, his wife, as fully and effectually, as if the legal coremony of marriage and its rites had never been solemnized.

CHAP. XXIX.—An Act to authorize the printing of certain laws in the several newspapers of the Territory.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota, That the Secretary of the Territory be, and he is hereby authorized and required to furnish for publication to the publishers of each and every newspaper now printed in the Territory, copies of all laws of a general character, passed by the Legislative Assembly; Provided, That the price paid for the same, shall not exceed one-half the rate paid for the publication of the Laws and Journals in pamphlet form.

SEC. 2. Said publication shall be made as soon as practicable after the laws shall have been filed in the office of the Secretary of the Territory.
