

October 11, 1849.

[No. 7.]—Joint Resolution relative to the "enacting clause" of the Legislature.

The enacting clause to the acts of the Legislative Assembly fixed.

*Resolved, by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Minnesota:* That the "enacting clause" to all acts of the Legislature shall be, "Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota."

APPROVED, the eleventh day of October, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.

October 11, 1849.

[No. 8.]—Joint Resolution authorizing the Secretary of the Territory to subscribe for certain papers, and for other purposes.

Secretary to subscribe and pay for each newspaper published in the Territory, and have the same bound, etc.

*Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:* That the Secretary of the Territory be and he is hereby authorized and required to subscribe and pay for one copy of each and every newspaper that may be published in the Territory beginning with the first number of such paper, and have the same bound and preserved in the Territorial Library.

APPROVED the eleventh day of October, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.

October 27, 1849.

[No. 9.]—Joint Resolution relative to the adjournment of the present Legislative Assembly.

Adjourn without day on first day of November, 1849.

*Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:* That the present Legislative Assembly shall adjourn without day on Thursday the first day of November next.

APPROVED, the twenty-seventh day of October, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.

November 1, 1849.

[No. 10.]—Joint Resolution relative to the temporary Seat of Government.

Temporary seat of government at St. Paul, and the Governor to rent suitable rooms therefor.

*Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Minnesota:* That the temporary Seat of Government shall be at St. Paul and the Governor is hereby required to rent suitable buildings for the Legislative Assembly and the Territorial Officers, to be paid for out of the moneys appropriated by Congress for Legislative expenses.

APPROVED, the first day of November, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.
